- 29 Cottage Hospital Ledbury Waiting restriction

There was some concern that proposals previously commented on by Ledbury Town Council did not appear on the above list. Members felt that rather than take a piecemeal approach, they should be taking a co-ordinated, holistic look at traffic related issues in the town. Following discussion it was decided that the matter should be referred to the Car Parking Working Party for further discussion, and that the working party's remit should be broadened to include traffic management related matters.
