The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a levy that local authorities can charge on new developments in their area. Once adopted, part of the money can be used to support development by funding new and improved infrastructure.

A 6 week public consultation starts on Thursday 17 March finishing Thursday 28 April 2016.
