**P.68 - 08.16 APOLOGIES**

Apologies were received from Councillors D Baker, A Crowe, M Eakin, J Roberts and N Roberts.

**P.69 - 08.16 INTERESTS**

The Chairman stated that whilst having no active interest in the Ledbury Swifts or Ledbury Football Club, he would declare a non pecuniary interest in Agenda Item 5.7 (P.72-08-16, 7) Planning Application [162103](#) as Chairman of Ledbury and District Sports Federation.

Cllr Warmington declared a non pecuniary interest in Agenda Item 5.8. (P.72-08-16, 8) Planning Application [162213](#) as the son of the contractor is known to him.

Cllr Francis declared a non pecuniary interest in Agenda Item 5.3 & 5.4 (P.72-08-16, 3 & 4) as he shops occasionally at the Co-op. A number of Committee members also pointed out that they occasionally shop at the Co-op.

**P.70 - 08.16 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

1. A resident of New Street spoke about agenda items 5.3 & 5.4 (P.72-08-16, 3 & 4) Co-op supermarket. He spoke on behalf of five owners of properties in New Street who had written collectively to

the Town Council stating their concerns about disturbance should the applications to vary existing conditions be permitted.  
A resident of Pound Close also voiced concerns about the loss of residential amenity and HGV traffic.

2. A local resident raised concerns about the caravan located at the Hereford Road roundabout. The Clerk reported that the matter had already been brought to the attention of Herefordshire Council.
3. Mr Richard Brixey, new Manager at the Coop Supermarket advised the meeting that he would be happy to meet with residents to discuss their concerns regarding the application and any existing issues they might have.
4. The Chairman of Ledbury Swifts football team spoke in support of Agenda Item 7, planning application 162103 (P72-08-16, 7) and gave background details about the application.
