

The Ledbury Food Bank opened in November 2012 with support from church groups, businesses and many others in the Ledbury area. It is now a registered independent charity.

We exist to relieve short-term hunger by distributing food and other household essentials on receipt of vouchers and in response to immediate need. On average, we distribute enough to feed more than forty people every week.

In the holidays and at weekends when free school meals are not available, adults sometimes go without food for days at a time to give it to their children. When the weather gets colder, many face the decision to "Heat or Eat".

For some, unexpected bills or benefits failing to arrive can lead to serious money problems. Our practical help can play a crucial part in supporting families at these times.



The Food Bank is on the first floor of St Katherine's Hall, the old building between the car park and High Street. We can normally supply food etc. for a period not exceeding six weeks, but this can be extended in exceptional circumstances.

As well as supplying food, we offer recipe sheets with ideas for economical home cooking, and often provide opportunities to taste dishes.

Clients are invited to identify particular seasonings or basic equipment to help them at home.

We welcome individual or regular cash donations, which are used to purchase food or equipment. Standing order and gift aid forms are available on request.
