**P.24 – 03.16 APOLOGIES**

**P.27 – 03.16 INTRODUCTION**

The Chairman introduced the following two speakers who spoke on the proposed development on the viaduct site:

Guy Wakefield of Hunter Page Planning acting on behalf of Bloor Homes and Nick Rawlings, Planning Director of Bloor Homes Western.

1. It was confirmed that initial discussions had taken place with the Canal Trust. There was a requirement within the adopted policy relevant to the viaduct site, i.e. a canal running through the site.
2. An outline application would be submitted for a phased development, the first phase of which was likely to commence six months after the outline.
3. 50-100 units could be delivered per year, subject to sales, therefore

the site could be completed within 6-7 years.

4. The infrastructure could include a primary school on the site.
5. The required open public space would be protected and maintained in perpetuity by a management company.
6. Full engagement with Ledbury Town Council was envisaged throughout the project.
7. A noise survey would be undertaken the following week and the findings from industrial and road noise levels would determine how close the properties would be to the noise source.
8. No highway matters had been decided. A transport assessment would be carried out, including traffic movements around the area and junction areas which Herefordshire Council wanted to look at.
9. The development would include 40% affordable housing, in accordance with Herefordshire Council's policy, unless there were complications such as contaminated land.
10. The development would incur Section 106 monies.

The Chairman thanked both speakers and they left the meeting.
