

E& L Committee Minutes 19 July 2018 (Closed Session) EX15/2018

The following items discussed are those deferred to the closed session at the end of meeting as they are items of a confidential or commercial nature.

E65-07.18 DOG HILL WOOD:

5.1 To consider pricing/quotes for the new picnic bench to be installed on the Cricket Pitch area of Dog Hill Wood.

Cllr Hopkins reminded committee members that the cost of this replacement bench was covered by the court order following the vandalism of the previous bench. Cllr Shields asked what type of bench was damaged – it was wooden, so it was agreed that a wooden bench would be chosen to replace it.

Cllr Eakin proposed that KDM-PB plus an anchor kit should be chosen. Cllr Hopkins seconded this.

Votes For: Unanimous.

RESOLVED: That picnic bench style KDM-PB plus anchor kit be chosen for installation.

E66-07.18 TOWN CENTRE

6.1 Grit Bins: To consider quotations for the supply of grit; to consider where any surplus grit would be stored. Cllr Roberts ask how many grit bins in total the Council will have if they buy the extra sets which have been requested by residents. The Temporary Clerk will find out the total figure. Cllr Shields reported that the public had expressed appreciation of the pavement gritting in the icy weather earlier in the year. It was discussed how and where bulk grit supplies could be handled and stored.

Cllr Hopkins proposed that the council explores other supplier options and storage facilities, such as using local Building supply companies including Bradfords and Travis Perkins, and also to explore cooperative buying options. Cllr Roberts seconded this.

E68-07.18 RECREATION GROUND.
